



NINTH ANNUAL VIRGINIA STATE CAPITOL ORNAMENT

Ninth in a series of collectible ornaments, the 2020 Official Capitol Ornament celebrates Old City Hall, currently being rehabilitated on the north side of Capitol Square. It was listed on the Virginia Landmarks Register in 1968, the National Register of Historic Places in 1969, and was designated a U.S. National Historic Landmark in 1971. Made in Virginia, the handsome 24K gold ornament is a perfect gift for colleagues and friends. Proceeds benefit the nonprofit Virginia Capitol Foundation whose mission is to restore, preserve, and interpret the Capitol, Capitol Square, and the Executive Mansion.
